



The Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) document will help you choose a health plan. The SBC shows you how you and the plan would share the cost for covered health care services. **NOTE: Information about the cost of this plan (called the premium) will be provided separately.**

<p>What is the overall <u>deductible</u>?</p>	<p><u>Network</u>: \$5,000 Individual / \$10,000 Family</p> <p><u>Out-of-Network</u>: \$10,000 Individual / \$20,000 Family Per policy year.</p>	<p>Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u>, each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u>.</p>
<p>Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u>?</p>	<p>Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> is covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u>.</p>	<p>This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the annual <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply.</p> <p>For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost-sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u>. <p>Are there other <u>deductibles</u> for specific services?</p>	<p>No.</p>	<p>You don't have to meet <u>deductibles</u> for specific services.</p>
<p>What is the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> for this <u>plan</u>?</p>	<p><u>Network</u>: \$7,150 Individual / \$14,300 Family</p> <p><u>Out-of-Network</u>: \$14,300 Individual / \$28,600 Family Per policy year.</p>	<p>The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u>, they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.</p>
<p>What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u>?</p>	<p><u>Premiums</u>, <u>balance-billing</u> charges, health care this <u>plan</u> doesn't cover and penalties for failure to obtain <u>preauthorization</u> for services.</p>	<p>Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u>.</p>
<p>Will you pay less if you use a <u>network provider</u>?</p>	<p>Yes. See myuhc.com or call 1-866-844-4864 for a list of <u>network providers</u>.</p>	<p>This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u>. You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the <u>plan's network</u>. You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u>, and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the <u>provider's</u> charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays (<u>balance billing</u>). Be aware, your <u>network provider</u> might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services.</p>
<p>Do you need a <u>referral</u> to see a <u>specialist</u>?</p>	<p>No.</p>	<p>You can see the <u>specialist</u> you choose without a <u>referral</u>.</p>

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.

Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? Yes

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.
